Employer Checklist for June 2007

- ✓ Ensure you are aware of the new Better Super rules as penalties may apply if employers do not abide by them
- ✓ Make your SG payments by 30 June (or by 21 June, if you use the Superannuation Clearing House) for potential tax deductions
- ✓ Email us should you wish to receive SuperSolutions as an email
- ✓ Check your SG contributions are going to complying RSE funds
- ✓ Remind your staff about the Government's Co-Contribution deadline.



Employee voluntary payments

Don't forget that your employees must make voluntary contributions before 30 June to qualify for the Government Co-Contribution. If employees have requested you make voluntary post-tax contributions on their behalf, make sure you submit their contributions before 30 June.
